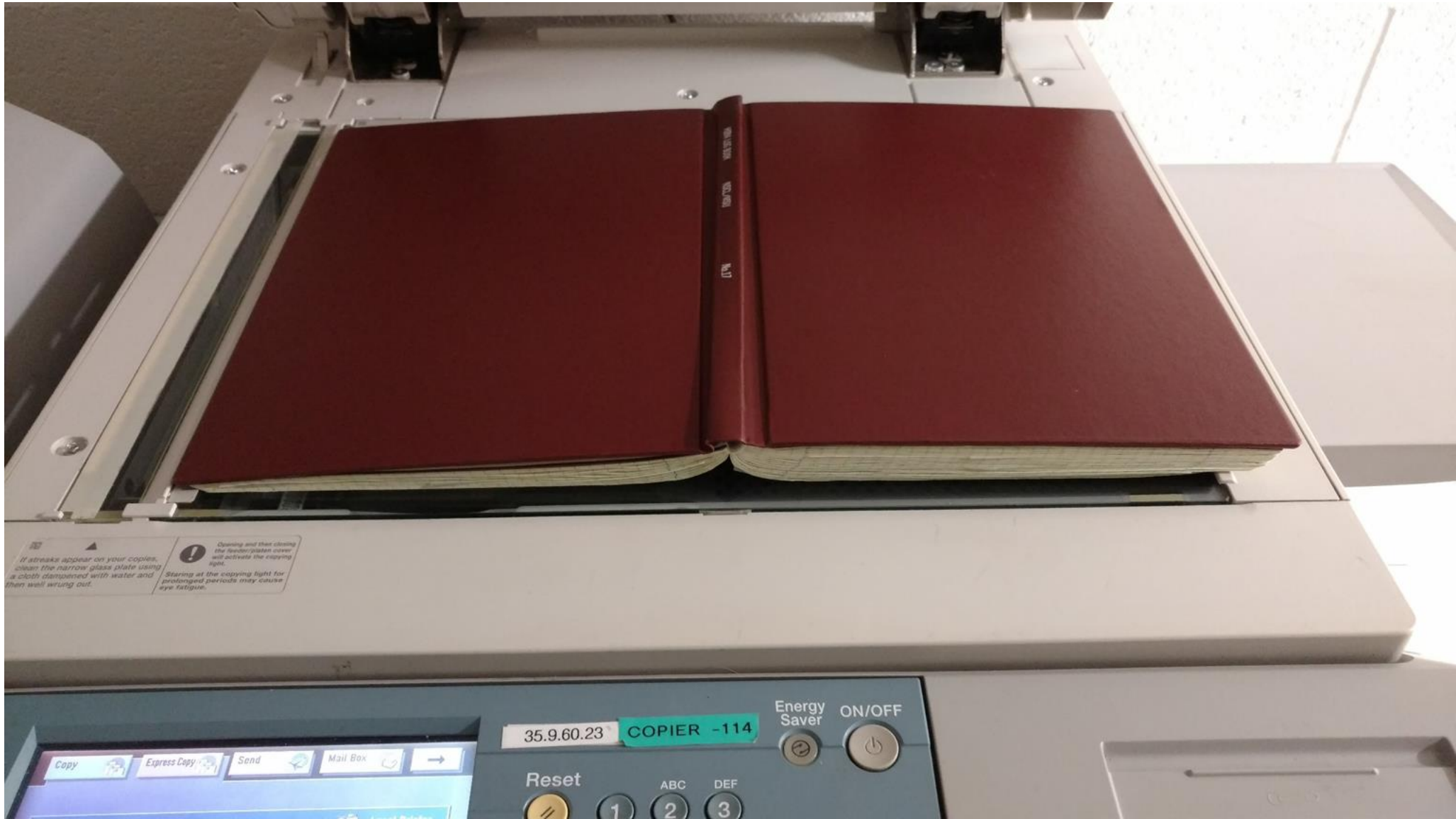


Scanning in the logbook

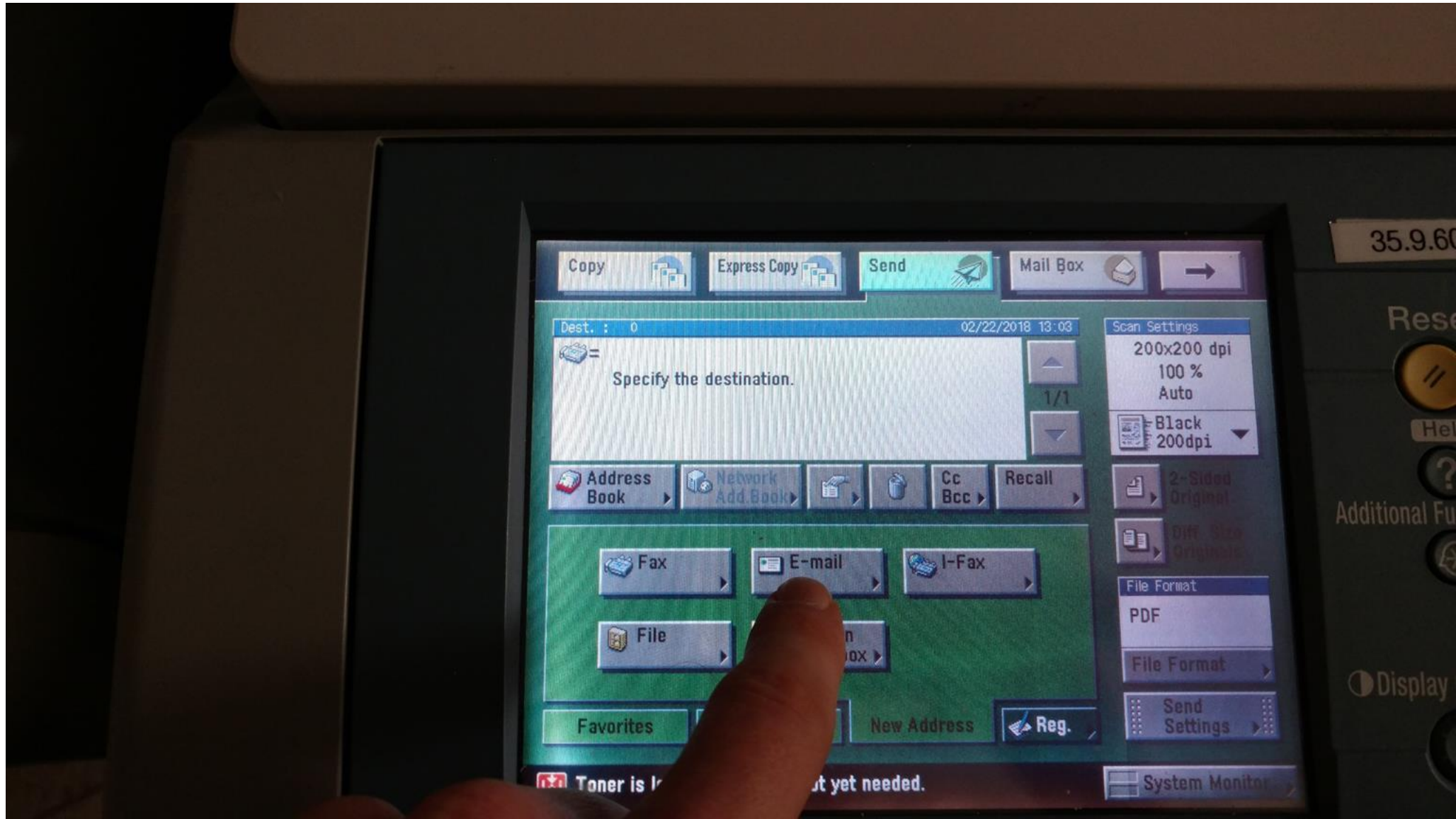
The logbook is oversized. This can cause some problems during scanning.



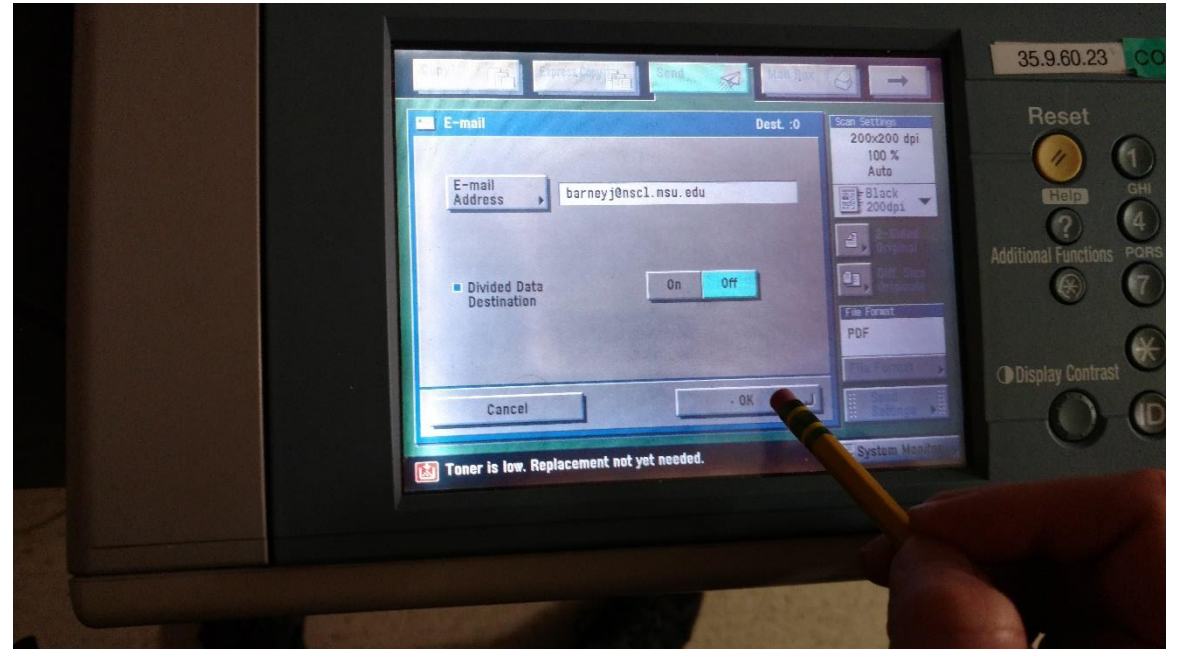
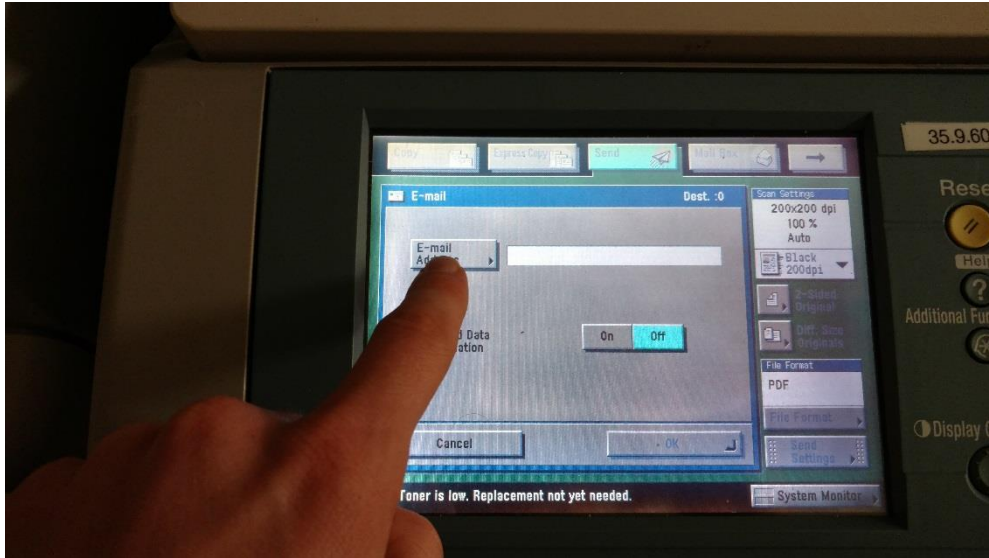
Hit "Send" to e-mail a pdf to yourself



Select "E-mail"

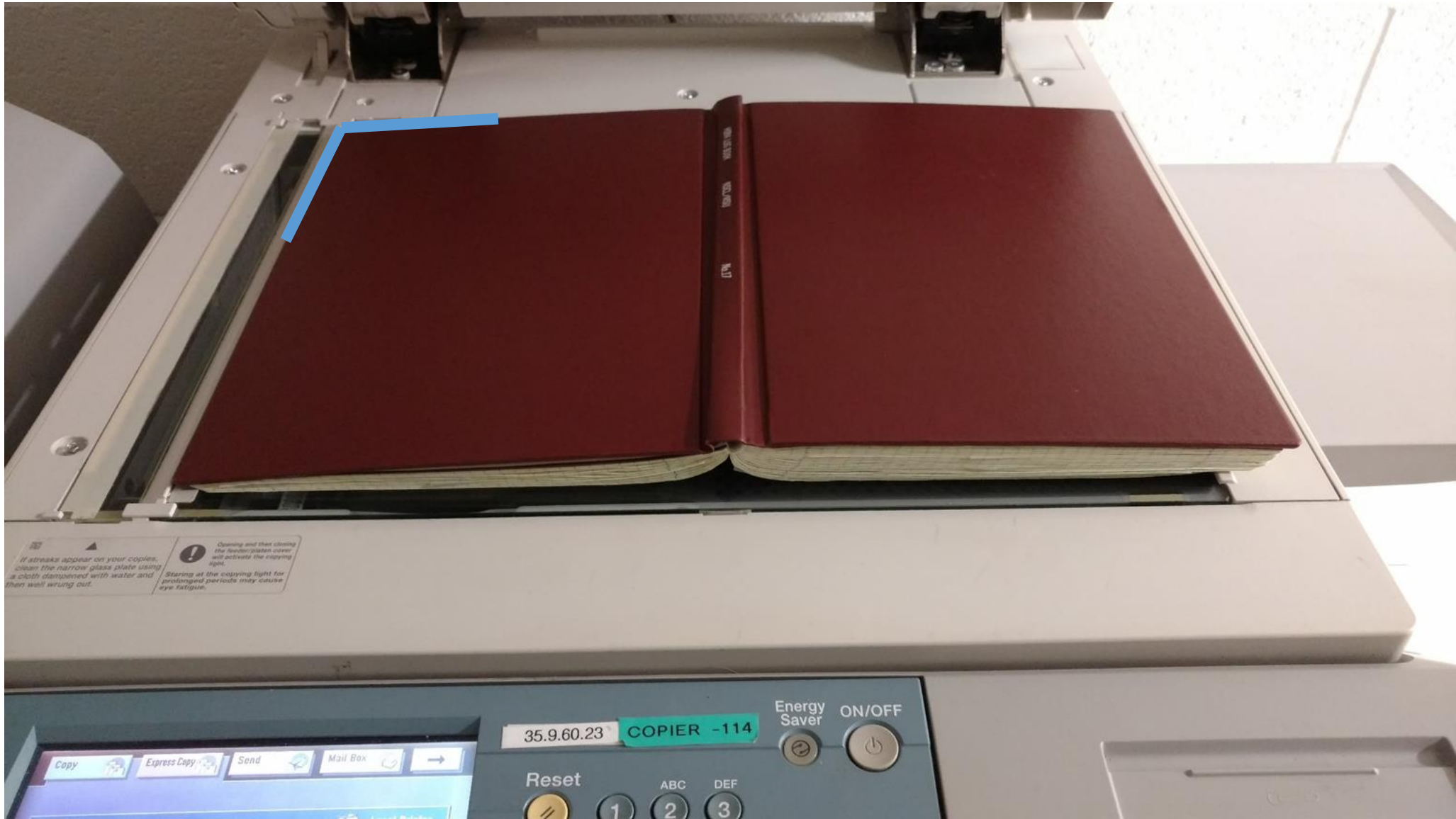


Put in your E-mail address

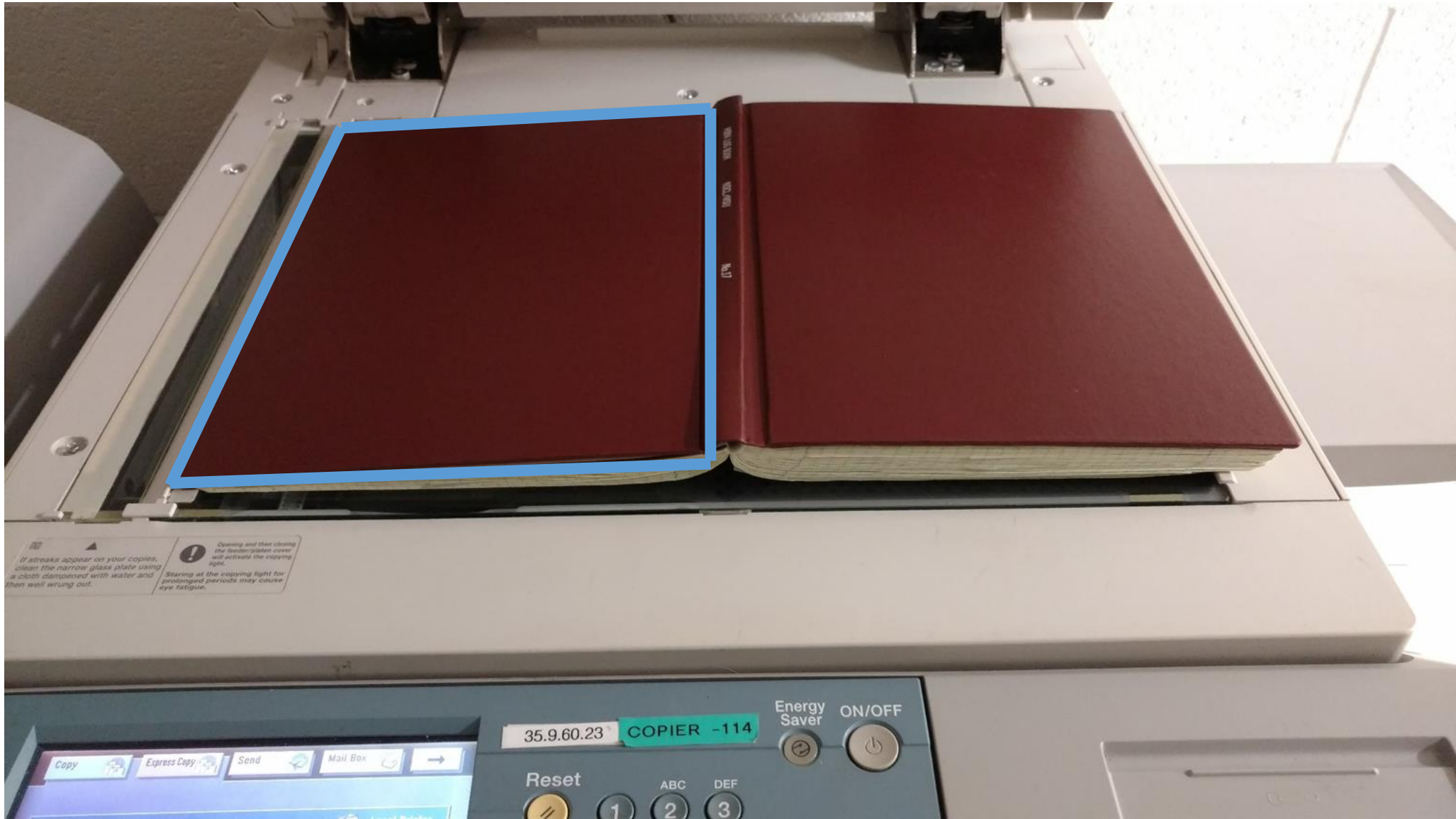


A pencil is helpful to type in the address. Hit "OK" if the e-mail is correct

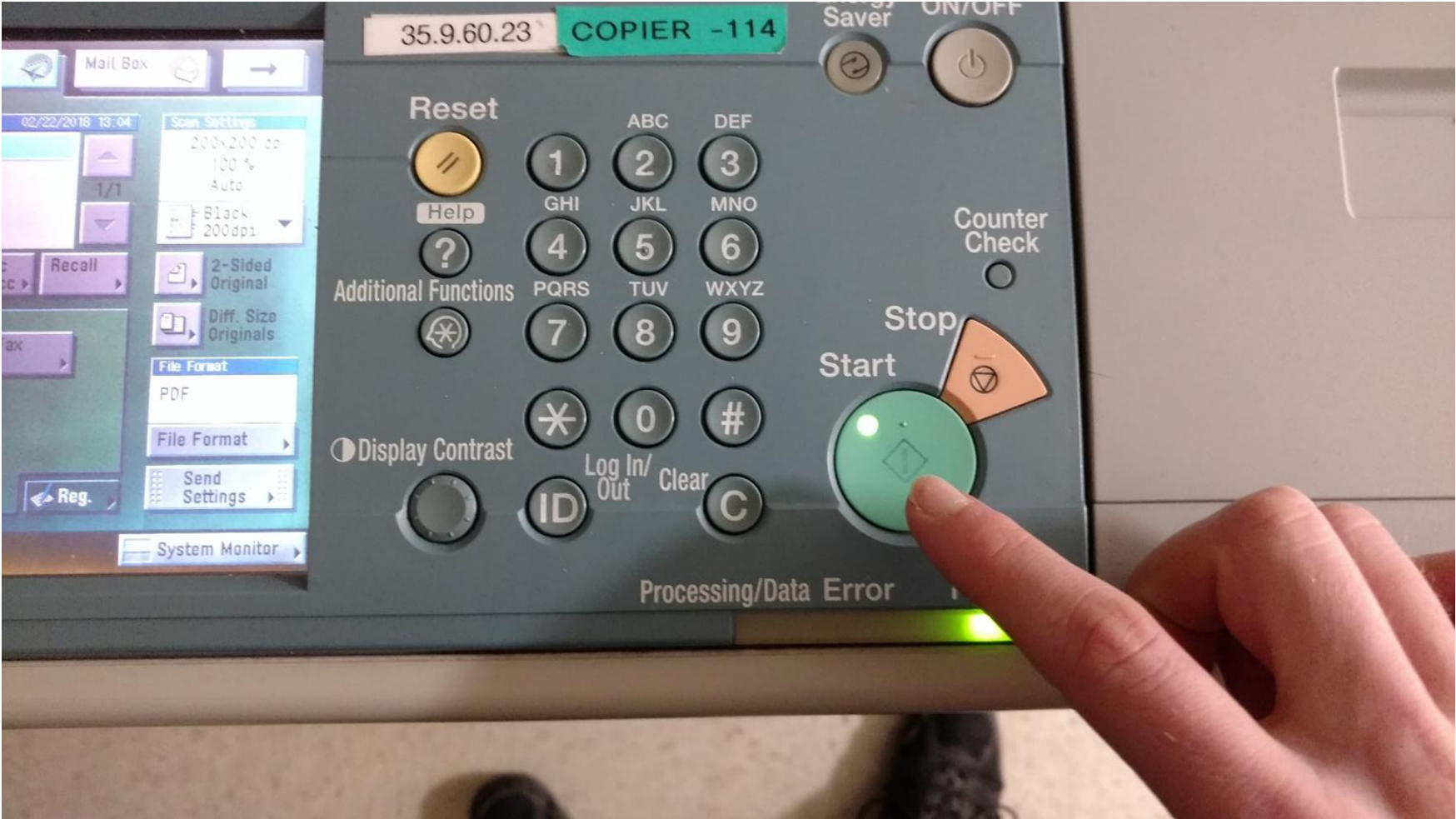
Place the logbook on the scanner, with the page you want to scan aligned to the top-left corner



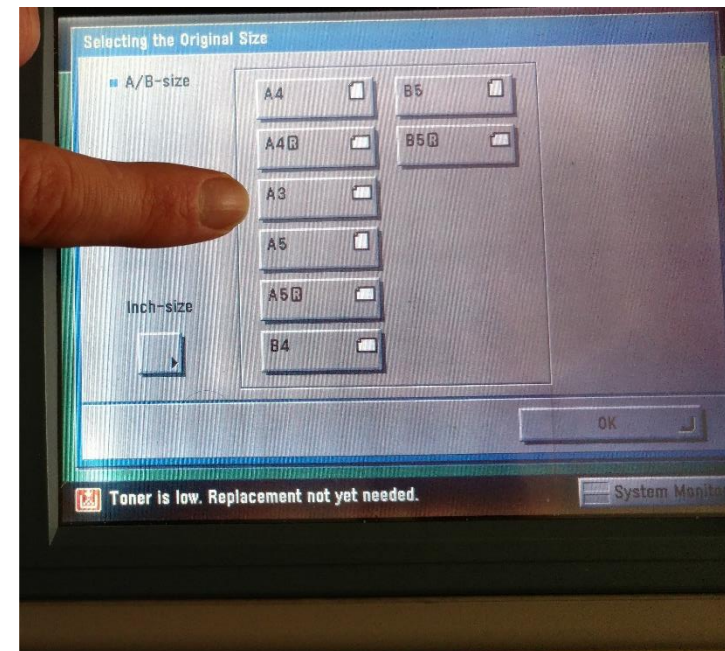
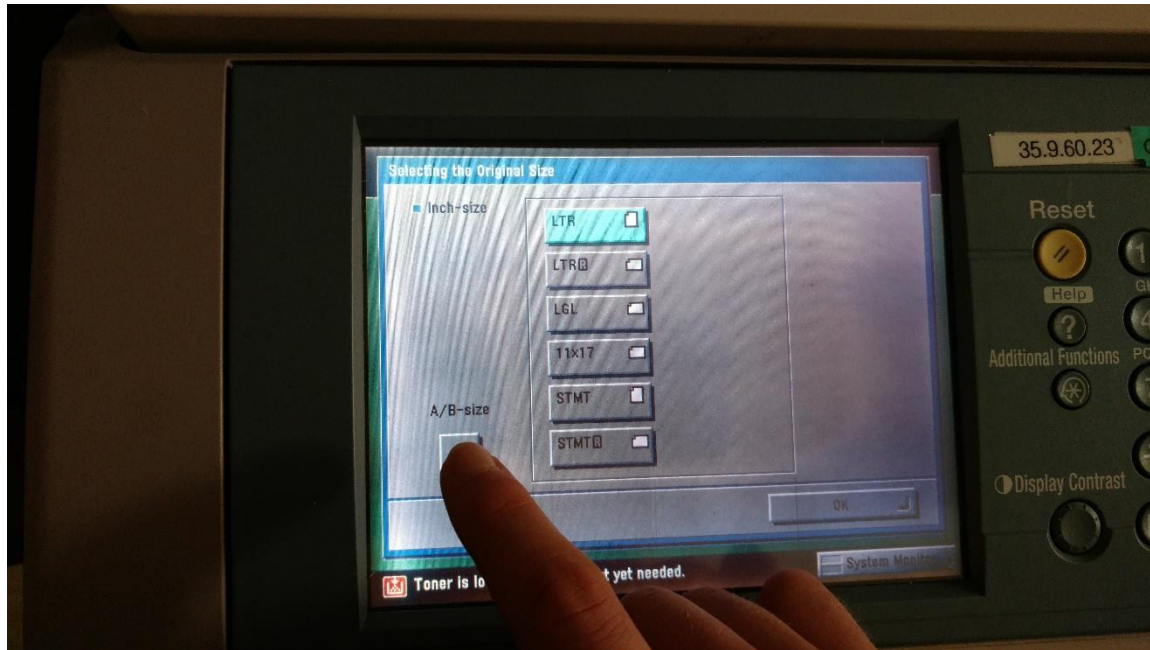
Make sure that the outlined page is entirely on the scanner, inside the “A3” lines



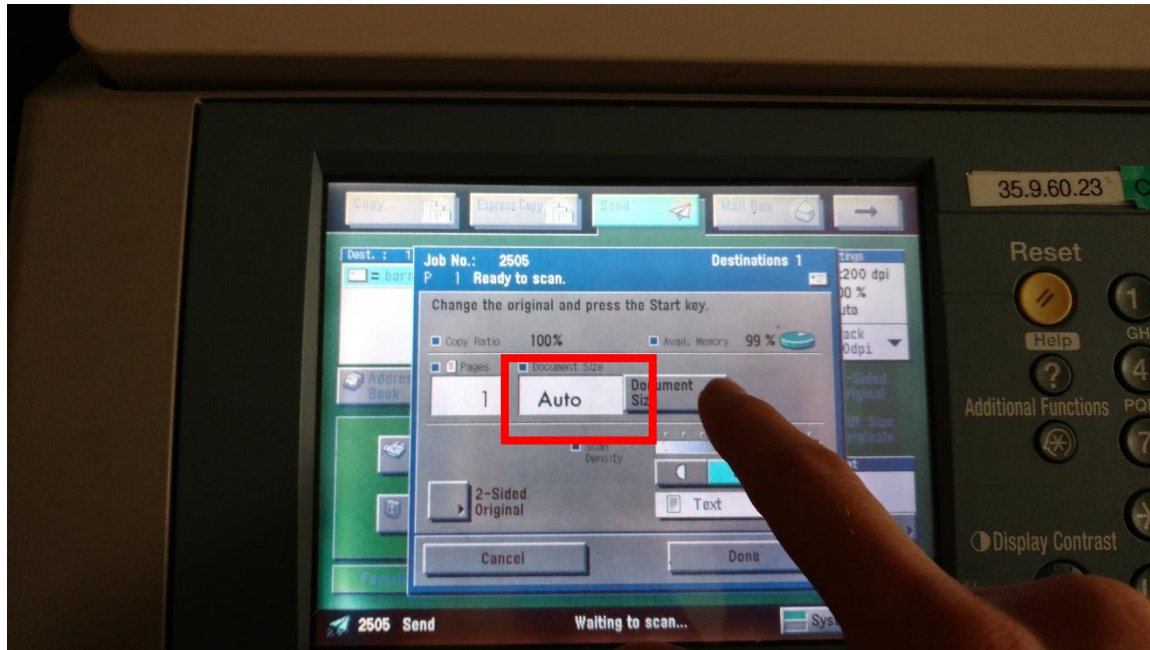
Hit the “Start” button to start the copy process



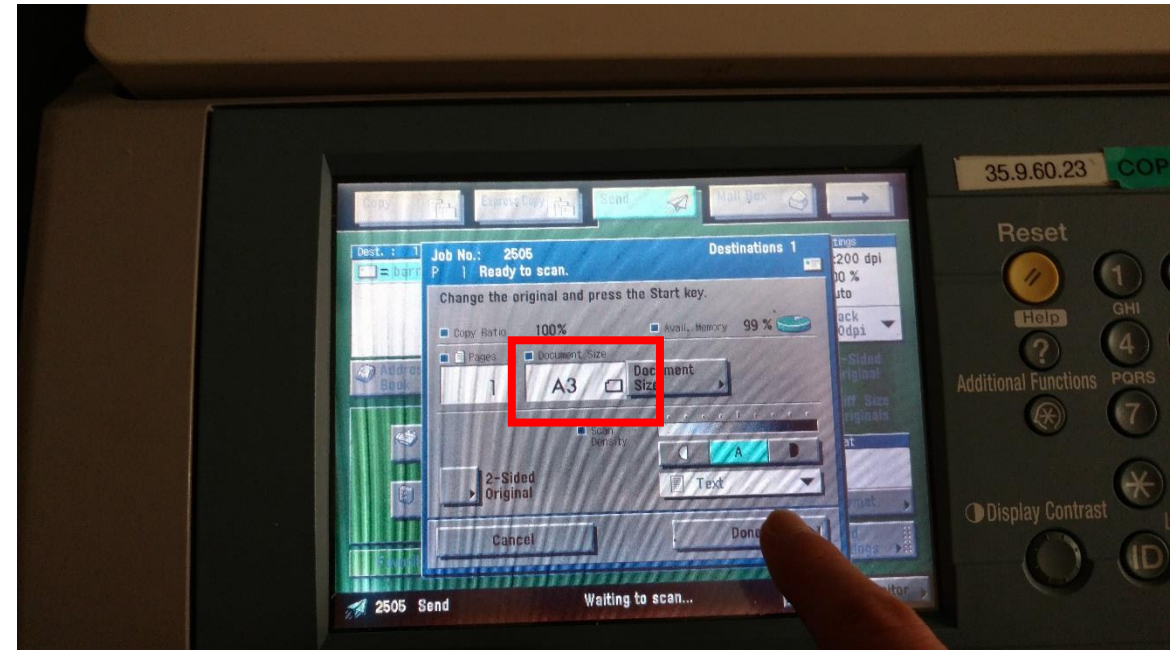
You may be prompted to select a paper size at this point. Select A/B size, "A3"



After the first page has been scanned, you should switch the document size from “Auto” to “A3”



Bad!



Good!

Run this command on fishtank/seaside with your file

```
pdftocrop --bbox "575 0 1200 850" yourfile.pdf
```

The above bbox was chosen based on original bounding box of 0,0,1200,850

Can determine the original bounding box by running:

```
pdftocrop --verbose yourfile.pdf
```
